English

This term we have planned a range of exciting English activities. We are currently looking at Little Red Riding Hood and will be moving onto Dumping the dachshund. The children will be focusing on Fiction this half term.



Maths

This term we will be focusing on place value. Reception children will be learning to use Rekenreks to understand numbers to 10 and build a greater understanding. Year 1 will be investigating numbers to 20. Yr 2 will be working on building their understanding of tens and ones and how to partition numbers to 100.

History, Science

In History we are learning about my families; children will learn about how childhood is different to when their grandparents grew up. The children will explore how it was different to growing up now. If grandparents would like to share their experiences with them at home or visiting Lime class we would love to hear from them.

In science this term we are looking at plants. Children will think about asking questions about the scientific world, plan and implement investigations to answer questions; and predict changes that occur.

P.E. and Games - Outdoor P.E. will be taught on a Friday. We also ask that earrings are not worn on these days and long hair is tied back. Children will be covering tennis this term.
