English

This half-term we have planned a range of exciting English stories. We will start by writing an explanation text based on Amelia Earheart and will then explore traditional tales from Denmark amongst other stories. Reception children will be looking at traditional tales.





Maths

In year one we will be continuing addition and subtraction within 50. Year 2 will be continuing with division. Both ear groups will also learn about length, height, capacity and temperature. In reception we will be focusing on mastering and deepening our knowledge of numbers

to 10. The children will focus on subitising, addition and subtraction.

Geography

In Geography we will be learning about the journey of food. We will look at where food comes from. One focus will be to explore how UK animals are reared and used for dairy and meat. On Monday we had a vist from a farmer with his tractor. Lime Class were able to ask him lots of questions



Science

In science this term we are looking at life cycles. We will explore life cycles of animals including humans.



Art

This term we will be looking at Kandinsky and Antony Frost for inspiration. The skill we will focus on is painting this term.





P.E. and Games - Outdoor P.E. will be taught on a Friday. We also ask that earrings are not worn on these days and long hair is tied back. Children will be covering tennis this term.

We also have a specialist dance instructor coming in this term to teach Bollywood dancing to the children.

Reading at home is beneficial to helping your child make progress. Please note in your child's diary when he/she has read. Some children have been able to tick lots of stars off in the reading challenge last term.

Reception children should practise their tricky words in their red books. These are words the children can not use their phonics to sound out.

KS1 Spellings- The children will receive spellings on a Monday and be tested the following Monday. Knowledge organisers are available to read through on the school website in the Lime class section. Children will bring home a book with some maths learning linked to what they are covering at school.
