<p>Key Stage 1: Literacy including guided reading, writing, spelling and punctuation and grammar will be taught through a range of different genres and texts throughout the year. We will work on a five-step approach of: plan it, draft it, revise it, edit it and publish it. This allows the children to see that writing is a process and we can support them through each stage of it to reflect the features expected in the different kinds of writing they need to produce. We will be learning through Grammarsaurus Writing units: Super Veg Crew - Persuasive advert and Instruction writing - How to be a Mighty Explorer.</p> <p>Reception: We will be learning to write names, mark making and letter formations. We will be sequencing story events and understanding how a story is structured. All this will be planned through topics such as Living things, Plants and Food from other cultures. The children will explore different books linked to these topics too. The children will sing Nursery Rhymes and build their vocabulary through circle times. Key Stage 1: Summer 2 - Geography: Our Wonderful World

We will be exploring the wonders of the world. We will learn which are man-made and which are natural. The children will exploring which countries these wonders are located.

Reception (Understanding the World):

We will be exploring the natural environment, making observations of the natural world, with particular interest in comparing similarities and differences in their natural world.

Summer 1: (Art)

Key Stage 1: Textiles

We will be exploring and learning through the work of Piet Mondrian. The children will discuss his modern and minimalist approach to art. They will learn about block printing and printing on to fabric.

Summer 2: (D.T.)

Key Stage 1: Stable structures- Building a structure that can stand against the wind.

The children will learn how to plan and design a structure that will with stand the force of wind. They will have the opportunity to evaluate their work.

Reception (Expressive Arts and Design):

The children will have the opportunity to explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour form and function. They will have the opportunity to share their creations, explaining the process they have used. The children will design, make and evaluate their own pirate ship using recycled materials.

Key stage 1:

Summer 1: Programming animations

We will be exploring animation and moving the sprites on a programme called Scratch Jr. the children will have the opportunity to program the sprite to do different tasks and build up sequences.


Summer 2: Programming Quizzes

We will be seeking to understand what we gain from quizzes. The children will have the opportunity to design and create their own quiz. They will be evaluating their own project.

Reception (Understanding the World):

The children will have the opportunity to use computers, Beebots and tablets with adult support in focus groups.

<p>Key Stage 1 and Reception: The children will be exploring different songs, rhymes and instruments. They will have opportunities to move to music to show and pitch with moving actions. We will learn through – The Rockpool Rock and Tanczomy Labada units on Sing up.</p> 	<p>Key Stage 1: Summer 1: Judaism – Leaders and Teachers Children will learn about Moses and his life. The children will learn about the 10 Commandments. They will learn about the Torah and where Jewish people pray.</p> <p>Summer 2: Christianity: Stories and Books Children will learn about parables and understand things that Christians believe about God from Bible stories. The children will have the opportunity to retell stories from the Bible and discuss what messages these stories are sending. <p>Key Stage 1: We will be recapping old graphemes and learning new. We will be using these in writing and reading. We will apply our phonics knowledge to every area of the curriculum.</p> <p>Reception: The children will be learning new graphemes, learning how to write and read them in words. The children will gradually build up segmenting and blending with the graphemes they know.</p> <p>Year 2 children will be accessing Fluency to gain a greater depth of reading and understanding of texts that they have read. All Year 1 and Reception children will be listened to in reading groups 4 times a week.</p>	<p>Key Stage 1: Relationships and RSE – Changing me Children will learn about families and difference between families. They will have an opportunity to learn about their bodies and how they change and grow.</p> <p>Reception (Personal Social and Emotional Development, Self-Regulation ELG): The children will develop these skills every day through following instructions, understanding school rules, sharing, regulating their emotions and experiencing for new situations and experiences. The children will also have the opportunity to have circle time to share a story and discuss particular topics such as kindness and what good friend looks like.</p>
